We worked on the short vowel sound Ee this week and specifically on the middle sound. This can be a hard sound as it sounds very similar to the short vowel sound li. I am impressed by the students’ reading skills and how much they are growing and working to become fluent readers! I am proud at all their accomplishments! Keep them reading at home and practicing their skills!

Math: We are on to Chapter 7. We have and will continue to work on the ‘teen’ numbers. These can be tricky for some kids, as they don’t sound the same as others. Please work with your students on these numbers from time to time.
