**Reading and Language Arts and Writing:** We have finished Unit 6 on Stories have Lessons. We read many fairy tales and fables that taught us something. Ask your children if they remember some of the stories and what we were to learn from it. We are continuing to read a lot in our classroom and the students are doing very well at working independently to read books on their own before reading to me. I am so proud at how far they have come and can't wait to see where they are at the end of the year. We worked on the letter Dd this week. Because of the really short week last week, we continued it this week. We worked on question words, plural and singular nouns, sentence structure (starting a sentence with an uppercase letter and ending with some kind of punctuation. The students are working hard at writing words on their own. Remember, they may and probably will be spelled wrong. They are writing the sounds they hear when they speak. For example my may be spelled mi, love may be spelled luv. This is just fine! I want them to do as much as they can on their own.

**Math:** We are on to Chapter 8. We are working comparing numbers and putting them in the correct order. We will also work on counting starting from a different number (7, 8, 9, 10). The teen numbers are still a bit of a struggle, so be sure to quiz them on those if you get the chance. We have filled our number chart in completely (to 100) and are now

working on skip counting by 2's, 5's and 10's during our morning meeting.
